## **Posting Scores and Yourway Version 14.1a**

## Week1 Web Site Uploads

This was the first day of posting meet scores and uploading meet result files to the website. There is a glitch in the division posting of meet scores that wipes out all previous league wide posted scores when a division posts their meet scores. The work around for this weekend was to post all the scores at one time from the league level. This will be fixed in time for each division to post meet scores for week 2.

As of 11:00 PM on Saturday, 35 out of 51 meet results have been uploaded. The remaining meet results should be uploaded by their divisions by noon Sunday.

## Yourway 14.1a Released

There is a problem with Yourway version **14.1** in that it will not accept 2004 meet result export files. In order to import meet result files, all teams need to install version **14.1a**. All export files created by version **14.1** are **valid** for uploading to the website and importing into version **14.1a**.

Version 14.1a installation software can be downloaded from the website by going to Documents and looking in the Yourway folder. There are 2 versions available. Some Internet Service Providers (ISPs) do not allow downloading of EXE files as a precaution for virus protection. You will need to download the V141a.ZIP file. You will also need an UnZip program such as WinZip (www.WinZip.com) to use this version. If your ISP will allow downloading of EXE files, you should download the self-extracting version, V141a.EXE.
