# Fairfax Area Swim Teams (FAST) Developmental Meet Rules and Procedures - 2017

The goal of the FAST Developmental meets is to provide competitive swim meets to those swimmers who have not had the opportunity to swim or to swim and be successful in the Saturday NVSL meets. Ideally, swimmers should have the opportunity to compete in at least two events per week, either on Saturday or on Monday.

Meets are not scored, and times are not official NVSL times; however, these are refereed meets designed to provide competitive conditions which are similar to the NVSL Saturday meets. Ribbons are awarded. FAST also hosts an Individual Medley (IM) meet, a Relay Carnival, and a Lollipop meet for novice swimmers.

EVENTS: Freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke, butterfly, and Individual Medley.

## ELIGIBILITY:

1. The eligibility of a swimmer to compete in a particular age group shall be determined by the Northern Virginia Swimming League rule 2.b from the current season handbook.
2. All swimmers are limited to a maximum of three events (two from free, back, breast, \& fly events) plus the IM.
3. An NVSL $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}$, or $3^{\text {rd }}$ place winner in a particular stroke in the last seven days is not eligible to compete in that stroke in the current B meet. If the $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}$, or $3^{\text {rd }}$ place was won by default or disqualification (DQ), then the swimmer may compete in that stroke. A swimmer does not become eligible by swimming up an age group.
4. Team Representatives, by mutual agreement, can add "exhibition" events to the meet for swimmers who would otherwise be ineligible to swim. Heats for these events will not be combined with other FAST event heats, and will be conducted after all scheduled developmental meet events.

## Rules for First Meet of Season (if it occurs before the first NVSL meet)

5. A swimmer's results from any dual A-meets from the previous NVSL season will be used in conjunction with the rules above to determine swimmer eligibility for the first FAST meet in the current season.
6. The first meet is not a "Time Trial." If a swimmer has no NVSL time from the previous season in a stroke, but the Team Representatives know the swimmer's best time in the stroke, the Team Representative should determine how the swimmer would have placed in the previous season NVSL meets and apply the eligibility rules above. If a swimmer is ranked \#1-3 on the team's ladder for a particular stroke, the swimmer should not swim that event.

## Fairfax Area Swim Teams (FAST) Developmental Meet Rules and Procedures - 2017

DATES: Meets take place on Monday evenings, starting the Monday prior to the first NVSL Saturday meet.

TIME: Meets begins at 6:00 PM Home Team Warm-ups 5:05 PM
Visitor Warm-ups 5:25 PM
Officials Arrive 5:30 PM
Officials: see attached sheet
Weather Problems: We swim rain or shine. If lightning occurs, swimmers should wait in cars until a decision has been made by the Team Reps for a delay, postponement, or cancellation. Meets can be delayed up until 7:30 PM. We will try make up meets as soon as possible (ideally the next evening) depending upon the host pool availability and mutual agreement of the Team Reps.

Ribbons: $1^{\text {st }}$ through $6^{\text {th }}$ place ribbons are awarded. Each team provides its own 1st through 6th place and competitor ribbons if they choose to use them. Ribbons will be given to $1^{\text {st }}$ through $6^{\text {th }}$ place finishers in each event. 6 and unders may be given 6 and under Star ribbons. Heat winner ribbons may be given at the conclusion of each heat.

Time Cards: Time cards must be available to the Clerks of Course for event seeding, and should be presented by the swimmer to the timers in the lane assigned to that swimmer.

Clerks of Course: The Clerks of Course will seed the events and heats by filling all lanes to the greatest extent possible. This is done by placing the swimmers, from fastest to slowest, in the lane order of $3,4,2,5,1,6$, with the fastest overall heat last.

Rules Update: These rules were reviewed and unanimously approved by the representatives from each FAST team on April 23, 2017.
