Pool Familiarization	<p>Pool Familiarization will be held on Sunday, July 12th, 8 – 11 AM for swimmers to become familiar with the pool and for the Coaches and Team Reps to become familiar with the site configuration. Site maps will be available and guides will answer any questions regarding the pool facilities and parking accommodations.</p> <p>All-Star T-shirts, Swim Caps, and meet programs will be available for purchase; a Happy Ads representative will be there to take orders and payments; and a variety of food will be available.</p>
Happy Ads	The deadline for submission of the Meet Program Happy Ads is 5 PM Sunday, July 12th. Ads submitted after that time cannot be accepted. Ads must be submitted electronically to nvslhappyads@gmail.com (PDF or JPG format preferred) and in its final version. Payment (checks made out to NVSL or cash) must be received by the end of pool familiarization.

Meet Day

Parking	<p>Primary parking will be in the neighborhoods adjacent to the pool (see attached map). Please do not park in intersections or block fire hydrants or driveways. Additional parking is available at Orange Hunt Elementary School. The Hunt Valley Elementary School and the Hunt Valley Pool Parking Lot is reserved for NVSL officials, vendors, and special guests.</p> <p>The pool will only provide 4 Handicapped Parking spaces during the day of the meet. Anyone needing handicapped parking must make prior arrangements with Linda Buckner (703-451-1972). People who do not make prior arrangements will not be able to utilize the Handicapped Parking; no exceptions will be made.</p> <p>No parking will be permitted along Sydenstricker Road from the team areas located at Community Covenant Church to the front of Hunt Valley Swim Club, which is the swimmer drop off zone.</p>
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Swimmer Drop Off	The designated Swimmer Drop Off area is located at the Community Covenant Church, 7018 Sydenstricker Road, and stretches to the front of Hunt Valley Swim Club. Please drop off swimmers and then proceed to the available parking areas. Handicapped Drop Off is at the pool entrance.
Team Areas	Team areas are next door to Hunt Valley Swim Club at the Community Covenant Church located at 7018 Sydenstricker Road, on the Church's field adjacent to the pool. Team areas may be set up after 7 AM on the meet day. Anyone near or on Church property and/or Hunt Valley Pool property before 7 AM will be considered trespassers and the authorities will be called.
	Tents and awnings are strongly encouraged. Grills, generators, and fires are NOT allowed in the team areas.
Viewing Areas	The Host Pool will open to the public at 2:00 PM.
	Lining up early to enter the pool area is strongly discouraged. The entry line prior to 2 PM is located near the sidewalk next to the Team Areas. Marshals will escort the line to the pool entrance at 1:55 PM to ensure an orderly admission.
	Reserving bleacher seats will only be permitted on half of the bleachers and will be clearly marked. Reserving bleacher seats with anything larger than a beach towel (approx. 6 ft. in length) is strictly prohibited. One person may reserve no more than two seats with one beach towel and must occupy that towel. Marshals will remove materials covering bleachers to "reserve" seats except as described above. Please encourage your swimmers to leave the bleachers open for adults and non-swimming children. Umbrellas will not be permitted in the bleachers.
	An area for disability seating and a disability restroom will be available.
	No access to bath house changing rooms or bathrooms will be permitted for participants or spectators. Portable restrooms will be located through the LRR grounds.
Results	As events end, results will be posted at meet. Full results can be found on the NVSL website after the conclusion of the meet.
Awards and Patches	Medals and ribbons are awarded for 1st through 18th places. All competitors and Alternates receive All Star Patches. Team Reps will pick up their team's medals, ribbons, and patches at the Awards Area after your team's last event. Trophies are awarded at the end of the meet to teams finishing with the six highest point totals.
Scholarship Awards	The MacDuff, Presidents, Spirit and Joan Olson scholarships will be presented at the meet after medley relay events.
Concessions and Vendors	Food and refreshments will be offered from the Host Pool and our NVSL food vendors. NVSL advertisers will have products for sale throughout the evening. Please support our advertisers!
Shop NVSL	NVSL Apparel, All-Star Shirts, Swim Caps and Programs will be on sale the meet.
