	LP is located inside a neighborhood near the intersection of Little River Turnpike and Braddock Road. Please see parking restrictions below, but there will be no parking on Montrose Street itself to allow traffic flow. LPRC can be reached via 395, 495, 95, or off highway routes, so check traffic for the best route when you are driving!
Happy Ads	The deadline for submission of the Meet Program Happy Ads is 5 PM Sunday, July 15th. Ads submitted after that time cannot be accepted. Ads must be submitted electronically to nvslhappyads@gmail.com (PDF or JPG format preferred) and in its final version. Payment must be received by the end of pool familiarization.
Pool Familiarization (Not to be used as a practice)	Pool Familiarization will be held on Sunday, July 15 <sup>th</sup> , 8 – 11 AM for swimmers to become familiar with the pool and for the Coaches and Team Reps to become familiar with the site configuration. It is not to be used as a practice.
	All-Star T-shirts, Swim Caps, and meet programs will be available for purchase; a Happy Ads representative will be present to take orders and payments; and a variety of food will be available.

## Meet Day

Swimmer Drop Off	The designated Swimmer Drop Off area is through the Holmes MS parking lot at the side closest to the pool. Drivers should enter on the Braddock Road side of the Holmes parking lot, and follow direction in front of the main entrance to drop off at the corner nearest to LPRC. Please drop off swimmers and then proceed to the available parking areas. Handicapped Drop Off is at the entrance to the pool lot.
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Parking	LPRC has arranged for parking at Holmes Middle School, next door, with a path through the trees to LPRC; Weyanoke Elementary School (across Braddock from Braddock Baptist); and Thomas Jefferson HS stadium lot (entrance on Braddock) with path to Weyanoke and cross Braddock with police crossing guard. Much of Braddock Baptist Church parking will also be available, but please pay attention to leave marked spots for their meeting. In order to maintain traffic flow, there will be no street parking on Montrose. There is street parking on side streets, but please use provided parking lots first to minimize neighborhood disruption. Please do not park in intersections or block fire hydrants or driveways. Commercial and large buses are to coordinate prior to the event with Andrew Wise at andrewwise5@gmail.com. The pool parking lot is reserved for working officials. Be a good neighbor - Follow the guidelines please!
	Some Officials parking (for working officials) will be provided in the LPRC parking lot. The LPRC parking lot will be used by meet volunteers with heavy loads & equipment, meet concessions and vendors, and special guests.
	The pool will only provide 4 Handicapped Parking spaces during the day of the meet. Anyone needing handicapped parking must make prior arrangements with Andrew Wise at andrewwise5@gmail.com. People who do not make prior arrangements will not be able to utilize the Handicapped Parking.
Team Areas	Team areas may be set up in the field surrounding LPRC, as marked, after 7 AM on the meet day. Anyone near or on the next door school property and/or LPRC property before 7 AM will be considered trespassers and the authorities may be called.
	Tents and awnings are strongly encouraged. Grills, generators, and fires are NOT allowed in team areas.
	LPRC will provide changing tents for swimmers who need to change on-site. No access to bath house changing rooms or bathrooms will be permitted for participants or spectators. Portable restrooms will be located close to the entrance on the LPRC grounds.

	The Host Pool will open to the public at 2:00 PM.
Viewing Areas	Lining up early to enter the pool area is strongly discouraged. The entry line prior to 2 PM will be marked. Marshals will escort the line to the pool entrance at 1:55 PM to ensure an orderly admission.
	Take pride in modeling Great Sportsmanship - Be a good neighbor!
	Reserving bleacher seats with anything larger than a beach towel (approx. 6 ft. in length) is strictly prohibited. One person may reserve no more than two seats with one beach towel and must occupy that towel. Marshals will remove materials covering bleachers to "reserve" seats except as described above. Please encourage your swimmers to leave the bleachers open for adults and non-swimming children. Umbrellas will not be permitted in the bleachers.
	An area for disability seating and a disability restroom will be available.
	No access to bath house changing rooms or bathrooms will be permitted for participants or spectators. Portable restrooms will be located at the edge of the field near the officials parking on the LPRC grounds.
Results	As events end, results will be posted at the meet. Full results can be found on the NVSL website after the conclusion of the meet.
Awards and Patches	Team Reps need to <b>pick up</b> their team's <b>awards and patches</b> at the awards area <b>before</b> <b>they leave the meet</b> . Medals and ribbons are awarded for 1st through 18th places. All competitors and alternates seeded All Star Relays receive All Star Patches. Trophies are awarded at the end of the meet to teams finishing with the six highest point totals. Check in with Awards shortly after the last event your team competed in.
Scholarship Awards	The MacDuff, Presidents, Spirit and Joan Olson scholarships will be presented before the start of the meet.
Concessions and Vendors	Food and refreshments will be offered from the Host Pool and our NVSL food vendors. NVSL advertisers will have products for sale throughout the evening. Please support our advertisers! No outside food will be allowed within the pool fence enclosure.
Shop NVSL	NVSL Apparel, All-Star Shirts, Swim Caps and Programs will be on sale at the meet.
