

NORTHERN VIRGINIA SWIMMING LEAGUE
2024 Scholarship Information and Application
Deadline for Submission: June 10, 2024, at 10:00 pm

Scholarships are awarded each year by the Northern Virginia Swimming League to recognize NVSL graduates' outstanding contributions to the league, their sport, and their communities, and to defray a portion of their continuing education expenses. Every graduating high school senior is encouraged to apply for the NVSL scholarships. Please note that athletes who have accepted swim/dive scholarships to a Division I or Division II school are, as a general rule, ineligible for an NVSL scholarship according to NCAA guidelines. For any other questions regarding eligibility, please refer to the current NVSL Handbook.

Swimmer/diver's commitment and contributions to their team and their sport are of primary importance. School and community involvement are also considered. The essay is a valuable opportunity to emphasize these attributes and allow the selection committee to learn more about the athlete as a person. The recommendation letters also enhance the committee's knowledge of the applicant and are a crucial part of the submission. A swimmer/diver does not need to continue competing in college to be eligible for these awards. **Grades and test scores are not considered.**

The scholarships will be awarded to the top five candidates. Each award for 2024 will be \$1,500. The following scholarships will be awarded:

Community Service Scholarship

Created in honor of long-time NVSL volunteer George MacDuff and his daughter Melinda. George served many years as the league's Records Chairman.

Excellence in Technique Scholarship

Created in 2017 by a grant from Mr. Lou Sharp's estate. Lou Sharp was a strong supporter of the NVSL through the Competition Swim Clinic that he founded. Under Lou's guidance, generations of swimmers learned their swim strokes and a love for the sport of swimming.

President's Scholarship

This scholarship was named in honor of all those volunteers who have served the youth of Northern Virginia and, in particular, those who have served as President of the NVSL.

Spirit Scholarship

Created in memory of Olivia Aull to recognize spirited swimmers and divers within the NVSL community.

Sportsmanship Scholarship

Created in honor of Joan Olson, a dedicated advocate for sportsmanship and long-time volunteer, who served as an NVSL Director and Seeding Committee Chair.

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Application Process:

A completed application includes four parts, in the following order: Personal Information sheet, Activities sheet, essay, and recommendation letter(s). Your name should be included on all pages of the application. The entire application should be converted into **one document in PDF format** before submitting. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

1. Request up to three people to write your recommendation letters. **At least one of these must be a person who is (or has been) affiliated with NVSL, who can attest to your commitment and involvement, such as a coach, team rep or parent volunteer.** The letters should be no more than one page, typed, and submitted as part of the **PDF format** application. Please do not submit separately. Your required NVSL-affiliated recommendation must be submitted for an application to be considered. The other two letters are optional. Be sure to ask your recommenders at least a couple of weeks before the due date to allow them ample time. Recommendation letters used for your college applications are acceptable for the two optional ones.
2. Complete both the Personal Information sheet and the Activities sheet.
3. Write a one-page typed (roughly 500 words or less) essay on **ONE** of the topics below. Please clearly identify your topic.

Topic 1: There are several ways that NVSL is different from other youth sports leagues. Describe some of these differences and why they are important to you.

Topic 2: As a high school senior, you have many demands on your time. Please describe your reasons for choosing to stay involved in NVSL.

5. Please convert all four parts of your completed application into **one PDF document** and email to: nvlscholarship@gmail.com, with subject line "NVSL Scholarship Application" **by 10:00 pm on the due date, June 10, 2024.** Please allow time for possible computer issues; do not wait till the last minute! You will receive an email reply to verify receipt. Late submissions will not be accepted.
6. All applicants will be notified by June 30, 2024. The winners will be posted on the website thereafter.
